* Comparing across state lines is difficult; because the systems are different, there is not a direct way to compare an Ohio School against a Michigan school. In these tables the statewide ranking of Michigan schools is used to compare against the statewide rankings of Ohio Schools against other Ohio schools. Statewide ACT scores for Ohio are 21.6 and for Michigan 21.5; statewide SAT for Ohio is Michigan 1700; Ohio performing better on ACT and Michigan better on SAT indicates neither state as a whole has a markedly better education system.
